Social Capital Survey of Central NJ

People in central New Jersey are better educated, more racially and ethnically diverse, and have higher incomes than national averages, key components for community involvement. But they are no more likely than their national counterparts to be engaged in civic activities despite average work and commute times that are two hours less per week than the national average, according to a ground breaking new Social Capital Benchmark Survey that was conducted in the Central New Jersey region. The Princeton Area Community Foundation and the Princeton Regional Chamber of Commerce Foundation are joining forces to help businesses and residents in Central New Jersey create more social capital. Over the next several weeks the two organizations will launch a five part initiative, to include an outreach campaign to key local leaders; an information campaign; a fall forum; a business and non-profit board recruitment and training program and a \$2.5 million dollar social capital grant program.
